

Where is Barry County?

- Barry County is part of the Region 4 Economic Development Collaborative
- Rural county of about 58K residents
- Conveniently located between Grand Rapids, Lansing, Kalamazoo and the lakeshore as a bedroom community

- Identified need for a chain hotel in Hastings in 1975
- 2006 adoption of the HomeTown Competitiveness model established in Nebraska and revised the model to fit Barry County "HomeTown Partners" (HTP)
- 2008 7 Elements of a Healthy Community - shift in grantmaking creating a Healthy Economy Fund



7 Elements of a Healthy Community



BCF Board Strategic & Priority Grantmaking

- Based on Seven Elements
- In 2008 as the economy tanked for many, Barry County's core base of employers remained strong albeit quiet about growth potential.
- BCF Board Selects Economy for Priority Funding, designating 40% of unrestricted grantmaking portfolio to the Economy Element
- The Balance or 60% funds the other 6 elements
