A Broken Municipal Funding Model



Like many cities, Kalamazoo faced increasing deficits as a result of Michigan's broken municipal funding model

- Reduced property tax revenue due to the Great Recession
- R
 - Rising healthcare and energy costs
 - Decreased state revenue sharing




Despite years of spending cuts and reduced personnel, the City was faced with an outlook of increasing deficits



Align City budget with community's priorities



Identify stable & sustainable sources of revenue



Responsibly Manage Legacy Costs



Legacy Cost Task Force convened in 2014 to study retiree healthcare costs, and identify workable solutions to manage them



75% of existing liabilities financed by OPEB bonds, estimated to save more than \$100 million over 30 years



Incentivize other cost containment strategies such as encouraging retirees to join Medicare, saving an estimated \$100,000 per year



Align City Budget with Community Priorities



Priority Based Budgeting model implemented in 2016 to refocus decision making around community priorities



City services organized into programs which are prioritized to maximize the impact of resources towards achieving results



Programs are refined and evaluated each year to maximize impact and improve outcomes



Identify Sustainable Sources of Revenue



Blue Ribbon Revenue Panel met throughout 2015 to explore options that could provide a sustainable revenue source



Many options were considered, 10 were explored in-depth, and 5 were recommended



The feasible recommendations continue to be pursued, but **did not fully address the need for sustainable revenue**



A New Option: The Foundation For Excellence



Continue status quo? More cutting? Reduce services? Pursue an income tax? Ask more of our residents?



How can we realize the vision we are asking our community to create in Imagine Kalamazoo 2025 with even more scarcity?



Mayor Hopewell and I approached our community partners to **explore and create a new option**, The Foundation For Excellence

Budget stability, increased community investment, and tax relief to property owners




A New Option: The Foundation For Excellence



Once fully-endowed, the Foundation For Excellence will sustain the work in perpetuity

\$70.3 million has been committed through 2019, during which time the Foundation For Excellence will be created and fully endowed (~\$500 million)

The Foundation For Excellence (FFE) will provide ongoing funding to:

Complete Imagine Kalamazoo 2025 visioning process and finalize Master Plan & Strategic Vision



By August 31, 2017:


Development and legal creation of FFE including incorporation, bylaws, IRS filings, and internal polices



Through June 30, 2019: Capital Campaign to fully endow the FFE



Your City Commission reallocated funds to build a squirrel sanctuary after an impassioned 4-minute plea during public comment







Set up all City plans for successful implementation with a guided framework




Shaping Our Strategic Vision and Plans
