#### **Course Details**

The MCPM program is paced out over a 10-month period and follows a convenient hybrid course format. The course consists of 5 face-to-face sessions, 5 virtual lectures, selected reading assignments, and a capstone project. This program is instructed by a variety of public management professionals, all of whom are graduates of the Michigan Certified Public Manager Program or experts in the field.

#### **Graduate Credits towards MPA**

Those who successfully complete the MCPM Course are also granted 6 credits toward the SVSU Master of Public Administration Program.
