



Purpose

The purpose of MME is to foster and encourage the personal and professional development of its members so that they may better serve their communities; and to promote and preserve high ethical standards for municipal administrators.

Board of Directors

The Board of Directors is made up of 16 members, each elected to a three-year term. Among these members is an Executive Committee, made up of the following officers: a President, a President-Elect, a Vice President, a Secretary/Treasurer, and the Immediate Past President.

Expectations and Responsibilities:

- Attend meetings in conjunction with the following MME events, and others as set by the President:
 - MME Winter Institute
 - MME Summer Workshop

Nomination Process:

- Direct electronic notice of the nomination period and Nominating Committee contact information is sent by the Secretary to each voting member by September 15 of each year.
- Nominations are accepted until October 15 to be considered by the Nominating Committee. This committee includes and is appointed by the President and President-Elect.
- The Nominating Committee develops a slate of candidates, with consideration given to candidates' prior service and dedication to the organization, as well as their geographic and demographic diversity to ensure broad representation on the Board.

Election Process:

- By December 1 of each year, the Secretary electronically sends a secure ballot to all voting members in the form of an online survey, with a voting deadline of December 15. Brief candidate statements are included in the election materials.
- The new Board directors and officers are announced and begin their terms during the MME Winter Institute each year.
